# ALL INDIA WEATHER SUMMARY AND FORECAST BULLETIN

# **Significant Weather Features**

- ◆ The **Low Pressure Area** over southeast Pakistan & adjoining southwest Rajasthan persists. However, the associated cyclonic circulation now extends upto middle tropospheric levels.
- The western end of the monsoon trough at mean sea level is south of its normal position and eastern end is near its normal position.
- ♦ A cyclonic circulation lies over southeast Uttar Pradesh & neighbourhood in lower tropospheric levels.
- ♦ Under the influence of the above systems:
- o Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with **isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning** very likely over North Interior Karnataka on 26th; Coastal Andhra Pradesh on 26th & 27th; Telangana during 26th-28th and over Rayalaseema, Tamil Nadu, Kerala & Mahe and South Interior Karnataka during next 5 days.
- o Fairly widespread light/moderate rainfall with **isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning** very likely over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura during 26th-28th; Arunachal Pradesh during 27th-29th and over Assam & Meghalaya during next 5 days. Isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over Arunachal Pradesh on 27th & 28th and over Assam & Meghalaya and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura on 27th August, 2022.
- o Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with **isolated heavy falls & thunderstorm/lightning** very likely over Bihar on 27th & 28th; Odisha on 27th; Jharkhand on 28th; southeast Uttar Pradesh and Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim during 27th-30th August, 2022. Isolated **very heavy rainfall** also likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim on 27th August, 2022.
- o Fairly widespread/widespread light/moderate rainfall with **isolated heavy falls and thunderstorm/lightning** very likely over Himachal Pradesh on 28th & 29th and over Uttarakhand during 27th-30th August, 2022.
- o Widespread light/moderate rainfall with **isolated heavy falls & thunderstorm/lightning** very likely over East Madhya Pradesh & Chhattisgarh on 27th & 28th August, 2022.

- ♦ Rainfall/thundershower observed (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today): at many places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands; at a few places over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, West Rajasthan, East Uttar Pradesh, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, East Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, East Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Punjab, Chandigarh, Saurashtra & Kutch, Odisha, Assam & Meghalaya, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Karnataka, Lakshadweep and Kerala & Mahe.
- ♦ Chief amount of Rainfall observed (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today):(7 cm or more): Bihar: Katihar: Katihar north-14, Manihari-11, Barari-8; East Uttar Pradesh: Varanasi-10; Tamil Nadu: Pandalur (dist Nilgiris) 9, Shoolagiri (dist Krishnagiri) 8 each, Avadi (dist Tiruvallur), Kovilpatti (dist Toothukudi), Vadapudupattu (dist Tirupattur), Hosur AWS (dist Krishnagiri), Edapadi (dist Salem), Omalur (dist Salem), Lakkur (dist Cuddalore) 7 each; North Interior Karnataka: Sedam (dist Kalaburgi) 9; South Interior Karnataka: Maddur (dist Mandya) 8, Kolar Pwd (dist Kolar) 7, Sompura Arg (dist Bengaluru Urban) 7; Telangana: Veepangandla (dist Wanaparthy) 9, Pebbair (dist Wanaparthy) 7, Alampur (dist Jogulamba Gadwal) 7; Jharkhand: Chatra-8; Coastal Andhra Pradesh: Chimakurthi (dist Prakasam) 8, Tadepalligudem (dist West Godavari) 7; Rayalaseema: Kalyandrug (dist Anantapuramu) 8, Santhipuram (dist Chittoor) 7; East Madhya Pradesh: Semariya (dist Rewa) 7.
- ♦ Heavy Rainfall observed (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today): Heavy rainfall occurred at isolated places over East Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, East Madhya Pradesh, Jharkhand, Interior Karnataka, Telangana, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Rayalaseema and Tamil Nadu.
- ♦ Thunderstorm observed (from 0830 hours IST of yesterday to 0830 hours IST of today): at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, East Uttar Pradesh, Telangana, North Interior Karnataka, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Kerala & Mahe and Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal.
- ♦Minimum Temperature Departures (as on 26-08-2022): Minimum temperatures are appreciably above normal (3.1°C to 5.0°C) at isolated places over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim; above normal (1.6°C to 3.0°C) at most places over Uttarakhand; at many places over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Bihar and Marathawada; at a few places over Assam & Meghalaya; at isolated places over Odisha and Telangana. They are below normal (-1.6°C to -3.0°C) at a few places over West Rajasthan, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal; at isolated places over East Madhya Pradesh and near normal over rest parts of the country. Today, the lowest minimum temperature of 20.6°C is reported at Mandla (East Madhya Pradesh) over the plains of the country.
- ♦ Maximum Temperature Departures (as on 25-08-2022): Maximum temperatures were appreciably above normal (3.1°C to 5.0°C) at many places over Uttarakhand; at a few places over Assam & Meghalaya; above normal (1.6°C to 3.0°C) at many places over West Uttar Pradesh, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam and Marathawada; at a few places over Bihar, Vidarbha, Odisha and North Interior Karnataka; at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, West Bengal & Sikkim, Madhya Maharashtra, Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Telangana. They were markedly below normal(-5.1°C or Less) at a few places over West Rajasthan; appreciably below normal (3.1°C to 5.0°C) at a few places over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad; at isolated places over Madhya Pradesh, East Uttar Pradesh and Tamilnadu, Puducherry & karaikal; below normal (-1.6°C to -3.0°C) at a few places over East Rajasthan; at isolated places over Saurashtra & Kutch and Kerala & Mahe and near normal over rest parts of the country. Yesterday, the highest maximum temperature of 37.7°C is reported at Ongole (Coastal Andhra Pradesh).

# Meteorological Analysis (Based on 0830 hours IST)

- ♦ The **Low Pressure Area** over southeast Pakistan & adjoining southwest Rajasthan persists. However, the associated cyclonic circulation now extends upto 5.8 km above mean sea level.
- ◆The **monsoon trough** at mean sea level now passes through center of **Low Pressure Area** over southeast Pakistan & adjoining southwest Rajasthan, Sikar, Sultanpur, Dehri, Purulia, Digha and thence east-southeastwards to Northeast Bay of Bengal.
- ♦ The cyclonic circulation over south Jharkhand & neighbourhood now lies over southeast Uttar Pradesh & neighbourhood and extends upto 3.1 km above mean sea level.
- ♦ A cyclonic circulation lies over southwest Bay of Bengal & neighbourhood at 3.1 km above mean sea level.
- ♦ A trough runs from the above cyclonic circulation over southwest Bay of Bengal & neighbourhood to interior Tamilnadu at 3.1 km above mean sea level.
- ♦ A trough runs from North Interior Karnataka to Comorin area across South Interior Karnataka & Tamilnadu at 0.9 km above mean sea level.
- ♦ The **Western Disturbance** as a trough in mid-tropospheric westerlies with its axis at 5.8 km above mean sea level roughly along Long. 68°E & to the north of Lat. 28°N has moved away northeastwards.
- ♦ The cyclonic circulation over south interior Tamil Nadu & neighbourhood at 5.8 km above mean sea level has become less marked.

# Weather Forecast for next 5 days \* upto 0830 hours IST of 31st August 2022

- ◆ Meteorological sub-division wise detailed 5 days precipitation forecast is given in Table-1.
- No significant change in maximum temperatures very likely over the country during next 5 days.

# Weather Outlook for subsequent 2 days During 31st August - 02nd September, 2022

- ♦ Fairly widespread to widespread light/moderate rainfall activity likely over south Peninsular India, West Coast, Northeast & East India, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand and north Madhya Pradesh.
- ◆ Scattered to fairly widespread light/moderate rainfall activity over remaining parts of the country except Jammu & Kashmir, Punjab, Haryana, West Rajasthan, Odisha & Gujarat State where isolated rainfall activity is likely.
